Biography

Kenneth A. Reinert is Professor of Public Policy at George Mason University where he received a Distinguished Teaching Award in 2003. He is also a Senior Fellow at Trade Partnership Worldwide. Professor Reinert received his Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Maryland and has held the positions of Senior International Economist at the U.S. International Trade Commission and Associate Professor of Economics at Kalamazoo College. He has consulted for the World Trade Organization, the World Bank, the OECD Development Centre, and the U.S. Department of Commerce.

Professor Reinert has published over 50 journal articles and book chapters in the areas of international trade, economic development, and environmental policy. He has co-edited *Applied Methods for Trade Policy Analysis: A Handbook* (Cambridge University Press, 1997), authored *Windows on the World Economy: An Introduction to International Economics* (South-Western Thomson, 2005), co-authored *Globalization for Development* (Palgrave MacMillan and World Bank, 2006 and 2007), and is Lead Editor-in-Chief of the two-volume *Princeton Encyclopedia of the World Economy* (Princeton University Press, 2009).
