Intensive FRENCH Language

Program led by Paula Gilbert of the Department of Modern and Classical Languages at George Mason University:

This four week French language program for beginning, intermediate, or advanced students takes place in Paris, the beautiful capital city of France. Prior to the program, students are tested at George Mason and placed in the appropriate level of study. Classes are 21 hours per week at the **Institut Catholique de Paris (ICP)** and are complimented by cultural activities and site visits. Students have free time in which they can take a weekend excursion to places like Versailles, Mont-Saint Michel, the beaches of Normandy, or St. Malo. There will also be opportunities for guided tours of Paris (home of the Eiffel Tower and the Louvre!) and a cruise on the Seine. Participants reside in double occupancy rooms at the Foyer International des Etudiantes which faces the Luxembourg Gardens and is only a short walk to ICP and the Latin Quarter.
