 - ◆ Who built it? When? Why?
 - ◆ What was its purpose?



◆ Part II – Newsletter

- ◆ Include 2-4 pictures.
- ◆ Provide background information:
 - ◆ Prominent Romans and what they were doing.
 - ◆ Current political and historical events.
 - ◆ Significant facts of social history.

Requirements continued:

◆ Part III—Model

- ◆ No larger than 3'x3'
- ◆ Accurate
- ◆ Durable

◆ Part IV--Multimedia

- ◆ 6-8 slides
- ◆ Presentation 5-7 minutes

◆ Part V – Website

- ◆ Survey
- ◆ Highlight information
- ◆ Other useful sites
