
Before you can use the E-Journal Finder

 - Article Title
 - Journal Title
 - Volume and Issue Number of the Journal
 - Date the article was published
 - Page Numbers of the article

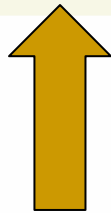

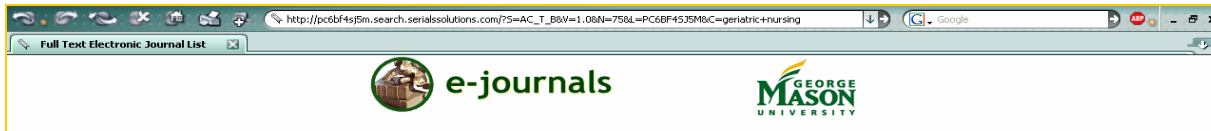

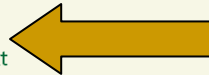

- Look for the volume number or the date you need
- Some databases put older issues in an Archive

the E-Journal Finder

- Search the George Mason University Libraries Catalog
- Search the WRLC Catalog
- Order the article from InterLibrary Loan
