Not Just a Language Class!

Submission Guidelines:

1. Participation is limited to students who are enrolled in a PK-16 world language class at the time of submission. ***Only one video entry per student (or group) please!***
2. Total video podcast length is not to exceed 2 minutes. On the video, please be sure to include:
 - a. Your first name only (NO LAST NAMES PLEASE!)
 - b. Your grade
 - c. The name of your school (NO CITY OR STATES PLEASE!)
 - d. The language(s) you are currently studying in school
 - e. How long you have been studying the language(s)
 - f. Why you chose to study the language(s)
 - g. How you use what you are doing in your language class in other areas of your life
3. A signed release/consent form must be included with the submission.
 - a. Students who are under 18 years of age and who attend a public or private school must return their signed release/consent forms to their world language teacher. The official release/consent form may be downloaded from: [\(insert website\)](http://(insert website))
 - b. Students who are under 18 years of age and who are home-schooled must have a parent or guardian complete an online consent/release form.
 - c. Students who are over 18 years of age and who are at a post-secondary institution must complete the online release/consent form.
4. The video podcast must be viewable by all audiences; “G” rating.
5. Submission process is as follows:
 - a. Video entries for students in grades PK-5, 6-8, and/or 9-12 must be submitted by the world language teacher. The teacher must have the signed release/consent form for each student entry. Visit the website at [\(insert website\)](http://(insert website)) for more details.
 - b. Video entries for home-schooled students in grades PK-5, 6-8, and/or 9-12 must be submitted by the parent or guardian by visiting the website at [\(insert website\)](http://(insert website))
 - c. Video entries for post-secondary undergraduate students over 18 years of age must be submitted by visiting the website at [\(insert website\)](http://(insert website))
6. Submissions that do not meet these guidelines will not be considered.
