Our Current Situation

The team met with client Dr. Michael Behrmann to discuss the results of the Needs Analysis and team recommendations for next steps. It was decided that the team will develop a conceptual framework for the Virtual Collaboration Center and produce a broad interface with user intention scenarios. One collaborative tool (Adobe Connect) and two development tools will be integrated within the interface.
